

SNOWMOBILE TO A HERITAGE FISHING VILLAGE

With bread baking in traditional wooden hut



We depart from your hotel and drive you to our headquarters in HaparandaTornio, where you try on your arctic gear (shoes, overalls, mittens). We drive around 15 minutes to the resort of Kukkolaforseen, on the Swedish shore of the river Torne. Here, after a security brief, you can try on your helmet and climb on **your snowmobile** (up to 2 persons per vehicle). We then drive up the **frozen river** or the countryside around the village for around 2 hours (we stop midway in order to take a break with a hot drink and switch driver).

We end our ride at lunchtime in the old fisherman village of **Kukkola**, where ancient traditions continue in spite of technology. Here, you can try your skills at traditional **bread baking**: we sit in an old wooden building around the open fire, and our guide teaches you the baking techniques using a special steel kettle. You taste your own bread with local whitefish salad. A delicious and entertaining experience.

Later, we guide you through the village, the fish museum, the old sawmill, the water mill, and some old houses dating back to the 18th and 19th centuries. Dive into the history of this incredible area and visit the fish museum, where you can learn how people have survived through the centuries in spite of hostile conditions.

Period: December 1st – April 15th (depending on snow conditions)

Duration: about 6h including transfers

Location: Haparanda (Kukkola)

Difficulty: generally easy and suitable for everyone, requires normal physical shape. B drivers license required

Gear: boots and overalls included. Please bring your own hat and gloves (mittens recommended)

Transfer: up to 40 km in private minibus

Pickup/dropoff: at your hotel lobby (one hour before) or at the LappOne Experience shop in Krannigatan 5 B (HaparandaTornio Resecentrum)

Group size: min 2 max 8 persons.

Languages spoken: English, Italian, other languages upon request

Timetable: 9-15 Sweden, 10-16 Finland (approximately)

Food and drinks: lunch, hot drink

Special requirements: upon request
